

**UPDATE ON PPKM POLICY IN INDONESIA
EFFECTIVE AS OF DECEMBER 6, 2022

In response to the lowering rate of Covid-19 spread, the Indonesian Government has adjusted restrictions on public activities (*Pemberlakuan Pembatasan Kegiatan Masyarakat*), known as PPKM. PPKM policies experience constant change based on instructions issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs in response to the latest epidemiological data on Covid-19. PPKM is implemented on a national scale.

A. Education Sector

Pursuant to Joint Decree of Minister of Education and Culture, Research and Technology, Minister of Religion; Minister of Health and Minister of Home Affairs No. 01/KB/2022, No. 408 of 2022, No. HK.01.08/MENKES/1140/2022, No. 420-1026 of 2022 on Guidelines for Implementation of Learning during the Covid Pandemic, face-to-face learning may be carried out for areas under PPKM Level 1 with regard to the following provisions:

1. If >80% of educators and education personnel and >60% of elderly citizens are vaccinated with the second dose, face-to-face learning is carried out:
 - Every day;
 - With maximum capacity of students is 100%;
 - With maximum in-person learning hours per day in accordance with the curriculum implemented in the relevant educational unit.
2. If <80% of educators and education personnel and <60% of elderly citizens are vaccinated with the second dose, face-to-face learning is carried out:
 - Every day but alternately;
 - With maximum capacity of students is 100%;
 - With maximum in-person learning of 6 hours per day.

B. Other Sectors

Kindly note in the summary below that:

- (i) relating to vaccination requirements, those who have not been vaccinated due to health reasons are excluded (the Covid-19 task force has confirmed that generally it is not required to show any supporting documents concerning the underlying health reason; however, the related institution may require one at its own discretion);
- (ii) people with green categorization in PeduliLindungi are those who have received the first and second dose of a Covid-19 vaccine;
- (ii) all of the activities are subject to the implementation of strict health protocols (regulated by the Ministry of Health and (if any) the relevant ministry and/or other regulatory authority) at all times;
- (iii) the PeduliLindungi application shall be used upon entering and exiting the premises to screen visitors and workers;
- (iv) in any public dining/drinking place, the maximum dining time is 60 minutes and only up to 2 persons per table; and
- (v) in any store, market, shopping center/mall/trade center, movie theatre, recreational and public facility, children below 12 years old must be accompanied by their parents/guardians and children between 6 and 12 years old must show a certificate evidencing they have received the first dose of a Covid-19 vaccination.
